

How to help me with Phonological Awareness at home

Before I'm ready to learn to read and write with skill and confidence I need to be able to do these things:

- Listen and give attention
- Hear difference between sounds
- Remember what I've seen and heard
- Know when one word ends and another begins
- Recognising and thinking of words that rhyme
- Recognising a word when you hear onset (first letter) and rime (rest of the word)
- Blending words

We work on these skills with our teachers and PSAs in school—playing games, working with stories and playing with words and sounds.
