#### Welcome to Hillside Nursery!



I hope everyone enjoyed a lovely summer break and I am so happy to see the our new and returning children settling so well into nursery over the past few weeks, engaging with their new environment and playing alongside all of their new friends! It has also been lovely to see all of the interactions that have already been taking place on ILD. We just love it when you share your child's achievements from home via ILD and we are beginning to print these photos and share them on our achievement board in nursery and using these in discussion with the children. For anyone who still hasn't quite managed to get on to ILD, please do let me know so we can remedy this and get you all set up and ready to go as soon as possible. With regard to our nursery drop off and collection routine, we are delighted to finally be able to allow parents back into the cloakroom area. Please be reminded that this area is still quite small unfortunately, so there may be a requirement to limit the number of adults that enter the setting at anyone time. Generally this may be around 3 families at one given time if possible. This will allow for some social distancing and will enable the children to be safely passed over to the nursery staff at the start of the session, or back to their adult at the end. Please also be aware that due to the size of the setting, there may be a variety of staff members greeting you and your child at the door. Please feel free to pass on any relevant information regarding your child and their care to any member of staff, but remain aware that you are welcome to ask to speak with your child's keyworker at anytime. If your keyworker is unavailable for whatever reason, we will make sure they contact you as soon as possible so please let us know how best to contact you should this be the case eg call, email, at the door. #### **Nursery Improvement Priorities**

# Clothing Reminder

We use our outdoor area throughout the session (rain, sleet, snow and sun) and so it is important that your child is wearing layers if possible so that they are prepared for every weather eventuality. Please also remember to label ALL removeable items so that staff can match these items to the right child at the end of each session.

'All Year' Families (50 week) - October Provision



If you have chosen for your child to attend nursery all year round, you will receive a form this week which will allow you to indicate your requirement over the October break period (17th-28th October 2022). We kindly ask that you return this form to myself (Mrs Middler) by *FRIDAY 23rd September 2022* as will allow us to plan for the provision and to ensure that appropriate staffing levels are in place.

#### **Nursery Catering**



From 1st August 2021, the Scottish Government have covered all catering costs for children in receipt of ELC funding. This means that the children are now enjoying a complimentary light snack, lunch or high tea whilst attending their usual nursery session. The menu is displayed on the nursey window for your perusal. We are happy to accommodate packed lunches where preferred, but please remain mindful that we are a NO NUT provision and that we no longer have the capacity to store packed lunches in the fridge. It is therefore advised that all packed lunches contain an appropriate cool pack to help maintain a safe storage temperature in line with food safety guidance and advice.
