### **Primary 1 Transition Information 2023-2024**



Preparations are now underway for the pre-school children transitioning on to Primary 1 from August 2023. All parents will receive an email from Mrs Grieve soon, detailing the transition process and an invitation to a short induction meeting and tour of the school on **Thursday 8th June 2023 at 6pm**. As part of our nursery sessions, pre-school children will experience all aspects of Primary 1 through organised visits and activities, in and around the school building and its grounds. The children will also have the opportunity to meet their teacher and explore their new classroom just before the summer holidays.

Alongside this, literacy homework packs will be issued to preschool children on a bi-weekly basis during the month of June. This is a lovely way to introduce the concept of sharing learning between home and school and provides an opportunity for the children to develop a sense of 'responsibility' and 'ownership' of their personally assigned packs.




