<u>School Improvement Plan</u> 2023-2024

Each session, we are required to submit our school improvement plan for the year. This sets out key tasks and work we plan to do as a school to raise standards. Improvement priorities are developed after rigorous evaluation and must be in line with local and national guidance.

Our SIP priorities for the coming session include:

To improve our universal and targeted approaches in supporting learners at Hillside School

Priority 2

To develop the use of Digital Technologies in the classroom.

Homework Reminder

Those of you who have been with us a while at Hillside will know that every few years, we review our approach to Homework. Homework is an incredibly divisive subject in all schools. We have many parents/carers who would like more homework and we have many who feel that there should not be any.

Over recent years there has been a significant decline in pupils completing homework. Despite this, we know that it is still important for many families and will continue to issue tasks.

Each term our class teachers issue a 'Learning Leaflet', outlining the curriculum focus across different areas. Families are always welcome to explore/practice skills further by referring to this.

So, with all this mind, below is a reminder of what Homework looks like at Hillside School.

P2-7 Homework

Class Teachers to post information about homework on TEAMS. (TEAMs are currently being created, your child should have access to their class TEAM in the next couple of weeks at which point Homework will begin.)

Weekly

- Oral Reading (pages to be read at home)

- **Spelling words** to be uploaded to TEAMS to practice if you wish.
- Recording task that will rotate weekly
 - Week 1 Topic Based
 - Week 2 Spelling Based
 - Week 3 Literacy Based

The marking of homework will be <u>minimal</u>. It could be stamped or ticked by the class teacher or self/peer marked. Any feedback could also be given orally.

Primary 1 families will have separate information given to them by the class teachers.

ILD



Our existing families will be aware that for the last few years we have used the Interactive Learning Diary as a profiling took for our learners. Parents have been able to see snapshots of learning at home and also add to this themselves. This is a tool widely used across different schools.

Aberdeenshire Council are withdrawing the use of ILD until a Data Protection Impact Assessment (DPIA) is completed. Unfortunately, this can take some time and, like the other schools using this system, we need to find an alternative profiling platform for this session.

As a team, we need to spend some time developing this. We will keep you up to date on any changes.

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Ball Games

Please note, the children have been reminded by class teachers and at our assembly that there should be no ball games in the school playground in a morning. While our SLT often try to come into the playground in the morning, this isn't always possible. School playgrounds are not staffed in a morning before 9am.

We will continue to remind the pupils of this rule.
