Clothing Reminder



Please provide your child with suitable clothes for the weather on a daily basis. We use our outdoor area throughout the session (rain, sleet, snow and sun) and so it is important that your child is wearing layers if possible so that they are prepared for every weather eventuality. Please also remember to label **ALL** removeable items so that staff can match these items to the right child at the end of each session.

As the weather is beginning to turn a little colder it would also be very helpful you could support your child to prepare their outdoor wear for the day ahead at drop off time whenever possible. This will reduce the amount of time staff spend in the cloakroom locating and retrieving waterproofs,

wellies, hats and scarves etc for every child which means more quality time can be spent with the children enjoying the outdoors.





Thank you to all of our 'All Year Round' families for confirming children's October Provision requirements. Session numbers have now been submitted to the **Catering** and **Early Years Team** and we look forward to enjoying another fun filled October break in setting.
