Nursery Christmas Dates



With Christmas fast approaching, I wanted to take this opportunity to share dates for the diary to enable you to plan ahead.

Christmas Fayre

The first event will be our annual Whole School Christmas Fayre which will take place on **Thursday 30th November 2023**. *More information has been provided on this event directly from the school*.

• Nursery Christmas Performance

The main event will of course be our highly anticipated **Nursery Christmas Performance**. As you may be aware, nursery use a child-led, play based approach to learning which we were able to showcase last year by using this approach to reflect on the children's favourite traditional tale at the time and were able to successfully produce a fantastic imaginative storytelling performance of 'Goldilocks and the 3 Bears at Christmas'. Our hope is to replicate last years success by using the children's current story of interest which is 'Room on the Broom' under the revised title of 'Make Way on the Sleigh!'. Nursery staff and children have already begun work on adapting this autumnal story into a wintery Christmas tale and we are all very excited to see where the children's imagination will lead us!

The Nursery Christmas performance will take place in the school hall and families will have the opportunity to sign up to either the **Monday 11th (9.30-10.30am)** or **Tuesday 12th (2.15-3.15pm) December 2023** performance. The performance will include a melody of familiar Christmas songs and the children will be supported throughout by staff and parents/carers. To support engagement

and interaction, seats will be positioned in a circle with the children in the middle and parents/carers will be invited to engage with and support their child at their level.

Christmas Lunch and Christmas Jumper Day

The children will also have the opportunity to receive a **Christmas lunch** whilst in setting on **Wednesday 13th December 2023** which coincides nicely with our annual **Christmas Jumper Day Fundraiser** in support of our very own Portlethen Larder. *More information will be provided on this event directly from the school.*

Nursery Christmas Parties

Finally, the **Nursery Christmas Parties** will take place on **Thursday 21st December 2023** during the morning and afternoon sessions. *If your child does not normally attend nursery on a Thursday, please feel free to join the afternoon party which will take place between 2-3pm. All children joining the afternoon session party should arrive at the nursery door prompt at the allocated drop off and collection time.*

Vision Screening - Tuesday 28th November 2023



Children with a birthdate of **March 2019 to February 2020** will have the opportunity to have a vision screening assessment carried out during their usual session on *Tuesday 28th November 2023*.

If your child is eligible for this vision screening opportunity, but does not normally attend nursery on a Tuesday and you wish to participate, please let a member of staff know and we will arrange a suitable time for you and your child to pop in past.

Scottish Cafe - Nursery Fundraiser Event

Clothing Reminder



Please provide your child with suitable clothes for the weather on a daily basis. We use our outdoor area throughout the session (rain, sleet, snow and sun) and so it is important that your child is wearing layers if possible so that they are prepared for every weather eventuality. Please also remember to label **ALL** removeable items so that staff can match these items to the right child at the end of each session.

As the weather is beginning to turn a little colder it would also be very helpful you could support your child to prepare their outdoor wear for the day ahead at drop off time whenever possible. This will reduce the amount of time staff spend in the cloakroom locating and retrieving waterproofs, wellies, hats and scarves etc for every child which means more quality time can be spent with the children enjoying the outdoors.
